## Clients served

In FY2014, **53%** of clients were asylum seekers and **26%** were refugees.

**76** psychological evaluations and **64** medical affidavits helped clients support their asylum cases.

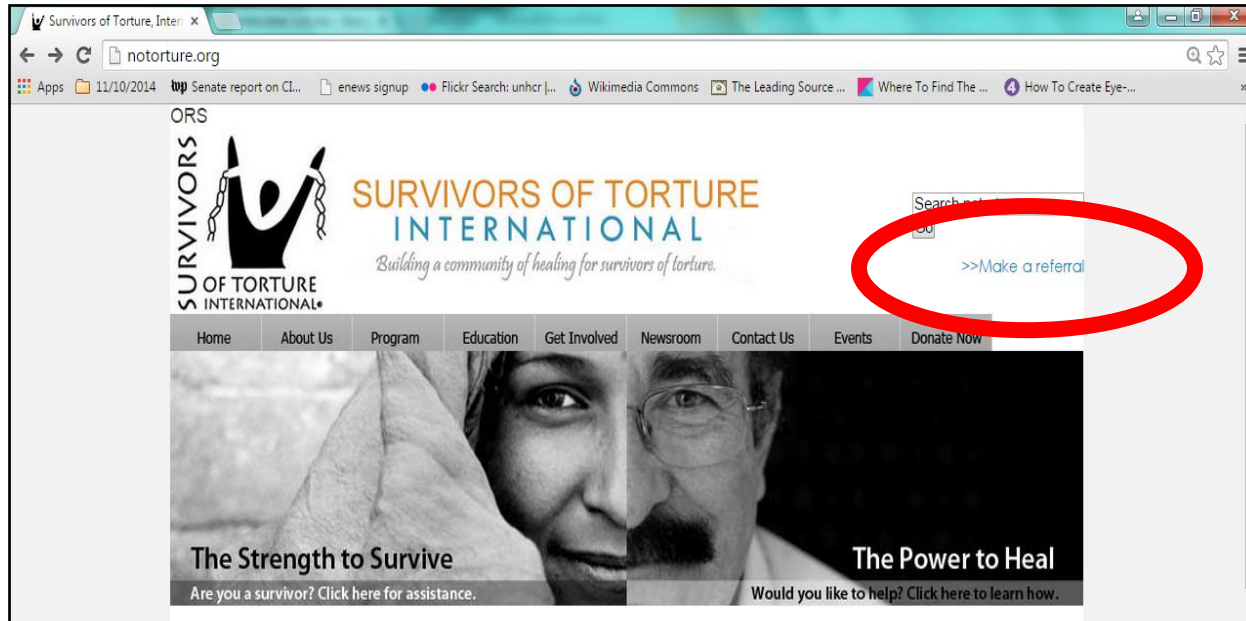
